LECTURER / TUTOR

LANCASTER UNIVERSITY MANAGEMENT SCHOOL

MNGT100/ MNGT120: Business and Management: an Introduction to Theory and Practice (Ugrad, 1st year) primary targets the first year students majoring in management. It assumes that participants have little if any experience of managing in organizations and equally, little or no prior knowledge of management theories. Thus, it seeks to introduce participants to the topic and provides the coverage of such topics as management theory, organizational strategy, organizational change, organizational behaviour, teamwork, leadership, corporate social responsibility and others. (Role: Lecture / Tutor)

MNGT121: Business Society and Business Environment (Ugrad, 1st year) is specifically designed to introduce international students to the background of business in the UK and EU and to help them to develop skills and practices needed for studying successfully and effectively in this context. It is therefore intended to enable international students to achieve their full academic potential. It covers a wide range of topics from study skills to basic knowledge of business issues. (Role: Lecture / Tutor)

MNGT200: Management (and) Consulting: Practice and Critique (Ugrad, 2nd year) aims to provide understanding about contemporary management practice through window of consultancy. It offers skills that enhance future engagement in work and employment. The focus of the module is to develop skills for organizational analysis and project management, and test them in practice through engaging in hand-on consultancy projects. (Role: Tutor)

MNGT501: Learning to Manage (Postgraduate/, MSc Level) constitutes a basic introduction to key theories of management at the Master's level. It seeks to develop understanding of wide management issues as well as builds on the critical thinking and analytical skills. (Role: Lecturer/Tutor)

MNGT 509: Qualitative Research Methods (Postgraduate/MSc level) is set out to prepare MSc student at the methodological level for researching and writing up the dissertations. It engages with such topics as ontology, epistemology and methodology of research as well as some study skills. (Role: Tutor)

MANAGEMENT CONSULTING (MBA LEVEL)

The purpose of this course is to introduce management consulting as a practice. It should create a common starting point for all students in the specialization Management Consulting. The course is about the nature of management consulting, communication by consultants, consultant-client relations, change, issues of professionalism and innovation of consulting methods.

ORGANIZATIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND CHANGE (MBA LEVEL)

The course aims to provide an understanding of various issues of organizational development and will pay particular attention to the concept of change. The course introduces consulting as a systemic activity and gives an overview of change as a systemic intervention. The course enables a dialogue between theory and practice preparing students not only to think critically, but also think pragmatically.

RESEARCH SEMINAR I & RESEARCH SEMINAR II (MBA LEVEL)

The courses aim to develop reflection on and critical evaluation the different research paradigms, strategies and methods. They also focus on training students on qualitative and quantitative data collection and data analysis methods.
